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Range Rules and Regulations:

1. Unload all firearms when entering at the unloading bay.
2. Handguns will be holstered or bagged unloaded, and magazine removed.
3. Rifles/Shotguns will be concealed in a bag and magazine removed.
4. The indemnity form must be completed before approaching the range.
5. Only the following types of firearms and calibres may be used on these ranges:
 - a. Handgun, Shotgun, Rifles, Self-loading rifles, Hand Machine Carbines.
 - b. Any calibre Handgun/shotgun/rifle not exceeding 12.7mm
6. Instructions given by the Range Officer shall be complied with unconditionally.
7. The safety officer will ensure that all rules and procedures are adhered to.
8. Red Flags must be on all flagpoles before shooting commences.
9. Do not touch or handle a firearm unless you are on the firing point.
10. Range Commands:
 - a. "You may load and make ready" – This means you may unbag and handle your firearm with muzzle towards the backstop.
 - b. "Are you ready" – The shooter can indicate if he/she has a problem
 - c. "Fire" / blow whistle – the shooter can start firing at their target.
 - d. "Cease fire" – The shooter stops firing immediately.
 - e. "Unload and show clear" – The shooter will unload their firearm and show the safety officer that the chamber is clear and magazine well / cylinder is clear.
 - f. "You may bag/holster" – The shooter may place the unloaded firearm in a holster or bag after inspection.
11. The firing point shall not be left with a loading firearm.
12. Use chamber flags where possible.
13. Firearms shall only be loaded at the firing point on the instructions of the range officer, with muzzle facing down range to the backstop.
14. Only targets provided shall be fired at. Under no circumstances shall any other material such as glass, tin cans or rocks be used as targets.
15. All targets must be within 5 metres of the backstop.
16. No shooting of wildlife on the range.
17. Turning around with a unbagged/unholstered/unloaded firearm is forbidden.
18. Firearms shall be holstered or put down unloaded, whenever shooting is interrupted for changing of targets. Under no circumstances may firearms be handled whenever anyone is in front of the firing point or without the expressed instruction of the range officer.
19. Other people's firearms may not be touched without the permission of the owner.
20. Eye and hearing protection shall be worn at all times during shooting.
21. No alcohol, or persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be allowed on the range.
22. All people not shooting will stay at least 2 metres behind the firing line.
23. If you have a problem at any point, alert the Range Officer with your non shooting hand.
24. If you notice any irregularities, please report it to the Range Officer.



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- 25. Children under the age of 18 may only conduct activities under the direct control of their parent or legal guardian. The child must remain within arm's reach in order to exercise direct control.
- 26. Breaching these rules may result in termination of membership.
- 27. Shooting competitions may take priority over regular usage.
- 28. Membership fee is for personal use only. For ANY business purpose use a MOU must be signed and approved by the range management.
